For problems 1 – 4 evaluate the given integral.

1.
$$\int_{\frac{1}{4}}^{2} t^{5} \left(4t^{2}-1\right)^{\frac{3}{2}} dt$$
 Note that you'll probably need a calculator to deal with the limits.

$$2. \int \frac{x^2}{\sqrt{2-9x^2}} dx$$

$$3. \int (x-1)^3 \sqrt{9x^2 - 18x + 13} \, dx$$

4.
$$\int \cos z \sqrt{16 + \sin^2 z} \ dz$$
 Hint : Look for a substitution that will make this look more like the first few problems in this section.

$$f(x) = \frac{x^5 + x^4 + x^3 + x^2 + x + 1}{x^4 (4 - 3x)(x^2 - 8x + 13)^2}$$

$$\int_{-1}^{0} \frac{4-7x}{(x+2)(3x-2)} dx$$

7.
$$\int \frac{3t^2 + 1}{(t-1)(t+2)^2} dt$$

$$8. \int \frac{4-z}{z^2 \left(z^2+16\right)} dz$$

$$9. \int \frac{x^4}{(x-4)(x^2+3)} dx$$
